— ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Who can apply

Entry to MSc in Business and Organisational Psychology.

- ✓ The academic entry requirement for LIBT graduates is completion of the Postgraduate Diploma in Business and Organisational Psychology (Level 7) awarded by LIBT. The general Coventry entry requirement of a 2:2 undergraduate degree does not apply to learners entering via this articulation pathway.
- ✓ IELTS: 6.5 overall, with at least 5.5 in each component area. If you don't meet the English language requirements, you can achieve the level you need by successfully completing a pre-sessional English programme before you start your course.

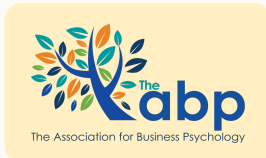
