Why This Course

The Undergraduate Diploma in Business Management is a **CMI-accredited qualification spanning Levels 4 and 5**, designed for working adults who want a structured, credible, and flexible route into business management without full-time campus study.

Delivered entirely online and fully self-paced, this programme builds the core management and leadership skills that contemporary organisations depend on. Across twelve modules, you will develop practical expertise in **communication, ethics, financial literacy, leadership, operations, marketing, project management, risk, entrepreneurship, HR, change management, and customer relationship management**.

The curriculum connects theory directly to real workplace scenarios, equipping you to make sound decisions, solve complex problems, and contribute meaningfully to any organisation.

On completion, you hold a **240-credit CMI-accredited qualification, become eligible for Foundation Chartered Manager status**, and gain direct entry to the final year of a BA (Hons) degree at Coventry University or the University of Essex.

Your Learning Journey

1 Key learning outcomes

This qualification gives you the management credentials, practical skills, and professional recognition to advance your career with confidence.

You will graduate with a **240-credit CMI-accredited undergraduate diploma and become eligible for Foundation Chartered Manager status through CMI**, a respected professional designation that demonstrates management capability to employers across every sector globally.

Across twelve modules, you will have developed expertise spanning communication, finance, leadership, operations, marketing, risk, entrepreneurship, HR, and change management. These are not abstract academic concepts. They are the practical skills that effective managers use every day.

The qualification also provides direct entry to the final year of the BA (Hons) in Business Management and Leadership at Coventry University or the BA (Hons) in Business and Management at the University of Essex, bringing a full UK bachelor's degree within reach.

2 Learn at your own pace

This programme is designed around one clear principle: your work and your studies should reinforce each other, not compete.

Everything is delivered online through **LIBT's feature-rich learning platform**, giving you round-the-clock access to recorded lectures, structured study materials, textbooks, and multimedia content. Each module carries approximately 80 guided learning hours, supported by an additional 30 to 50 hours of optional materials including recommended readings, self-testing exercises, and curated online resources.

The programme is fully self-paced across 240 credits, so you can move through Level 4 and Level 5 modules at a pace that suits your professional and personal commitments. On-demand tutoring is available at no additional cost, with tutors reachable by email, phone, or video call whenever you need support.

3 Assignments based on real situations

Assessment on this programme is entirely **assignment-based**. There are no traditional examinations. Each of the twelve modules is assessed through a single written assignment, making twelve submissions in total across the full programme.

Assignments are designed to be work-related wherever possible. You will be expected to engage with relevant management theory, apply it to real organisational scenarios and case studies, and where appropriate draw directly on your own workplace experience. Every submission requires clear reasoning, original thinking, and practical application appropriate to the level of study.

For working adults already managing teams or processes, this model is a natural fit. Your professional experience is not separate from your academic work here. It is actively encouraged as the foundation of your analysis and recommendations.

4 Credit for your learning and experience

If you have prior study in business, management, or a related field, or significant relevant professional experience, you may not need to complete every module from scratch. **LIBT's Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)** process assesses whether your existing knowledge and competencies meet the requirements of specific modules.

Where your prior learning is verified as current, credible, and directly relevant, you may be awarded academic credit for one or more modules, reducing your study commitment and helping you qualify sooner.

RPL is assessed on an individual basis. Evidence must be specific to the module in question and must demonstrate achievement at the appropriate level. To explore whether your background qualifies, contact our admissions team or visit our dedicated RPL guidance page before you apply.

— ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Who can apply

Entry to Undergraduate Diploma in Business Management.

- ✓ Two A-levels, a Level 3 qualification, a Foundation award, or equivalent, plus a minimum age of 18.
- ✓ IELTS 5.5 or equivalent is a standard regulatory requirement for undergraduate study. If you have studied or worked in English, our admissions team will be able to assess and map your prior experience against the required standard.

Or

- ✓ GCSE Maths and English at Grade C or above, plus at least three years of relevant work experience.
- ✓ The same English language and age requirements apply.

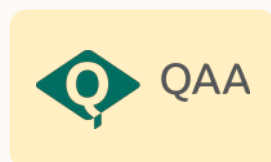
